1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CM(M) 2140/2025 & CM APPL. 69709/2025 (stay)

2. Petitioner/defendant has assailed order dated 17.09.2025 of the learned trial court, whereby conditional leave to defend the suit under Order XXXVII CPC was allowed. Paragraph 14 of the impugned order details the grounds on which the learned trial court found it a fit case to grant leave and paragraph 15 of the impugned order details the reasons for which the learned trial court found it fit to impose the condition of deposit of 50% of the principal suit amount within six weeks.

3. Presently, it is not clear if the suit has already been decreed on account of non-compliance with the condition. As mentioned above, the conditional deposit was to be within six weeks and the present petition was



filed on 03.11.2025 as per filing logs.

4. Subject to petitioner/defendant taking steps within one week, notice through all modes be issued to the respondent, returnable on 24.03.2026 before Joint Registrar.

5. It is made clear that there is no stay on proceedings of the trial court.
