1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 10/11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers:

“(i) To initiate contempt proceeding against the alleged contemnors for willful and deliberate disobedience of orders of this Hon'ble Court and non-compliance of the direction contained in judgment dated 04 Aug 2025, passed by this Hon'ble Court in WP (C) No. 7597/2024, titled as UNION OF INDIA & ORS VS. HAV KEDAR KIRANKUMAR UDHAV (RETD).

(ii) To pass any other further order(s) as may be found necessary and expedient in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that *vide* order 21.07.2023 in OA 961/2020, the petitioner's application for grant of disability pension on the ground that he suffers from CNS (INV) Seizure Disorder with 20%



disability for life, rounded off to 50% for life was allowed by the learned AFT.

4. Subsequently, the aforesaid judgment passed by the learned AFT was challenged before the learned Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) 7597/2024 and *vide* judgment dated 04.08.2025, the same was dismissed with direction to comply with the directions passed by the learned AFT within four weeks.

5. Issue notice.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents accepts notice. Let a compliance report be filed before the next date of hearing.
