Digit General Insurance Ltd. [“the Insurance Company”], as no right of recovery has been granted against the driver [respondent No.1] and owner of the offending vehicle [respondent No.2].

3. Accordingly, notice be issued to respondent No.3 – the Insurance Company, by all permissible modes, including through the learned Standing Counsel/Nominated Counsel, if any, as well as through the counsel who had appeared for the Insurance Company before the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal [“the Tribunal”].

4. Reply to the application seeking condonation of delay be filed within six weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.

5. The Trial Court record be requisitioned, and electronic copy thereof be placed on the file of this appeal.

6. Written submissions to the appeal may be filed by the parties with reference to the electronic record of the Court, alongwith copies of any relevant judgments which they wish to rely upon, within eight weeks from today, without prejudice to their rights and contentions in the pending application.

7. List before the learned Registrar on 16.01.2026, for completion of service and pleadings.

8. List before the Court on 25.03.2026.
