The application stands disposed of.

CM APPL. 70457/2025(Condonation of delay in refiling)

1. This is an application seeking condonation of delay in refiling of the captioned appeal.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 61 days in re-filing is condoned.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

MAC.APP. 719/2025 and CM APPL. 70458/2025(for stay)

4. The appellants are the driver and owner of motorcycle bearing registration No. DL-9SW-9437, which was involved in an accident in which the respondent sustained injuries. They assail an award of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal ["Tribunal"], by which a sum of ₹5,89,791/-, alongwith interest, has been awarded to the respondent-



claimant.

5. Mr. Vipin, learned counsel for the appellants, confines the scope of the appeal to the grant of pecuniary damages of ₹1,70,100/- towards reimbursement of medical expenses. He submits that the medical bills placed on record before the Tribunal (which, unfortunately, have not been annexed to the appeal) show that payment of bills was, in fact, made through medical insurance of the claimant and not by the claimant personally.

6. Issue notice, limited to this question, to the respondent-claimant, additionally through learned counsel who had appeared on his behalf before the Tribunal.

7. The Trial Court record be summoned, and electronic copy of the same be placed on the file of this appeal.

8. Written submissions to the appeal may be filed by the parties with reference to the electronic record of the Court, alongwith copies of any relevant judgments which they wish to rely upon, within eight weeks from today.

9. Subject to deposit of the awarded amount, alongwith interest thereupon, before the Tribunal within six weeks from today, execution of the award to the extent of ₹1,70,100/- and proportionate interest thereupon shall remain stayed until the next date of hearing.

10. List before the learned Registrar on 21.01.2026.

11. List before the Court on 25.03.2026.
