1. The present suit has been filed seeking recovery of a sum of Rs. 4,51,01,583/-, along with interest.
2. The pre-litigation mediation in terms of Section 12A of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015, initiated by the plaintiff has not been successful.
3. Let the plaint be registered as a suit.
4. Issue summons.
5. Summons be issued to the defendants through all permissible modes. The summons shall state that the written statement(s) shall be filed by the defendants within thirty (30) days from the date of the receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file affidavit(s) of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record.

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6. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication(s), if any, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replication(s) filed by the plaintiff, affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the defendants be filed by the plaintiff.
7. The parties shall file all original documents in support of their respective claims along with their respective pleadings. In case parties are placing reliance on a document, which is not in their power and possession, its detail and source shall be mentioned in the list of reliance, which shall also be filed with the pleadings.
8. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.
9. List before the Joint Registrar on 19th January, 2026, for completion of service and pleadings.
10. List before the Court on 25th March, 2026.
