1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers: -

“a) Initiate contempt proceedings against the Contemn under Article 215 of the Constitution of India and Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for willful neglect and disobedience, non compliance of the Final Order, dated 24.07.2025, passed in Writ Petition (Civil) bearing No.7976/2024 by this Hon'ble Court.

b) Award cost and exemplary damages in favour of the Petitioner and against the Contemnors for causing harassment and undue hardship to the Petitioner.

pass such other or further order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. *Vide* order dated 24.07.2025 in W.P.(C) 7976/2025, learned Division Bench of this Court had passed the following directions: -



“13. Accordingly, we set aside the Impugned Order dated 04.04.2024 passed by the learned Tribunal, as also the notice of retirement dated 10.07.2023 issued by the respondents herein.

14. The respondents shall reinstate the petitioner to her service. For the period that the petitioner has not worked, the respondents shall release 50% of the wages to the petitioner, however, for all other benefits, the period between the termination of the services of the petitioner and her reinstatement shall be notionally counted as one spent in service.”

4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent accepts notice.
6. Let a compliance affidavit be placed on record before the next date of hearing.
7. In case of non-compliance, the concerned Officer shall remain present in the Court on the next date of hearing.
