3. The present petition has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter 'Act') seeking appointment of a Sole Arbitrator for the adjudication of disputes between the parties arising out of a Concession Agreement dated 28th July, 2010 (hereinafter 'Agreement') entered into between the parties.
4. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the Agreement contains an



arbitration clause, *i.e.* Clause 44.3, which provides for adjudication of any disputes arising between the parties by way of arbitration.

5. He further submits that since there were disputes between the parties, the petitioner sent a notice dated 21st July, 2025 to the respondent invoking the aforesaid arbitration clause under Section 21 of the Act.

6. It is submitted that since the respondent has raised irrelevant and extraneous objections *vide* letter dated 15th September, 2025, the petitioner has been constrained to approach this Court by way of the present petition.

7. None appears on behalf of the respondent despite advance service.

8. Issue Notice.

9. Notice be issued to the respondent through all permissible modes.

10. If the respondent wishes to contest the present petition, reply may be filed within two (2) weeks from today.
