**CM APPL. 76182/2025 (for condonation of delay of 03 days in
depositing the demand draft)**

1. By way of order dated 19.11.2025, execution of non-bailable warrants was stayed till 23.03.2026, subject to the petitioner/judgement debtor complying with his undertaking to deposit the entire balance decretal amount with the Registry of this Court within one week. It was also clarified that if the said amount is not deposited, there shall be no continuation of protection and the arrest warrants already ordered shall be executed.
2. Despite that order, the total amount outstanding as on date has not been deposited. By this application, petitioner/judgement debtor seeks condonation of delay in depositing the balance amount. But the amount deposited is not the balance amount.
3. As reflected from the mediation settlement (*page no. 116*), on which the decree under execution was passed, the present petitioner had to pay a total amount of Rs.10,00,000/- to the respondent/decreed holder at the rate of



Rs.1,00,000/- per month from April, 2025 till 15.01.2026. In other words, as on date, Rs.9,00,000/- should have been paid. But learned counsel submits that he has not deposited the entire amount of Rs.9,00,000/-.

4. Since order dated 19.11.2025 has not been complied with, I find no reason to grant further opportunity.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner/judgement debtor on instructions submits that as on date, an amount of Rs.7,25,000/- already stands paid or deposited and the balance amount of Rs.1,75,000/- shall be deposited by the petitioner/judgement debtor with the Registry of this Court within three working days and the balance amount of Rs.1,00,000/- shall be deposited on or before 15.01.2026. Last opportunity is granted to the petitioner/ judgement debtor to deposit the amount of Rs.1,75,000/- with the Registry of this Court within three working days and the balance amount of Rs.1,00,000/- on or before 15.01.2026 and subject to doing the same, the warrants of arrest already ordered against him be not executed till next date. But it is made clear that if the said amounts are not deposited in time, the warrants shall be executed.

6. In view of the above discussion, the demand draft filed with the application be accepted by the Registry and accordingly, the application stands disposed of.
