1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 73681/2025 (Exemption)

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application is disposed of.

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3. The present petition under Sections 2(b), 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeks the following prayers: -

“a) Initiate contempt proceedings under Sections 2(b), 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the Respondent/Contemnor Dr. M Beena for deliberate, conscious and wilful disobedience of the order dated 12.11.2025 passed by this Hon’ble Court in W.P.(C) 16872/2025;

b Call upon the Respondent/Contemnor Dr. M Beena to show



cause why he should not be punished for contempt of court for violation of the directions issued by this Hon'ble Court;

c) Declare that the allotments made on 12.11.2025 as well as the allotment of six additional unclaimed stalls are illegal, void and in breach of the explicit restraint order of this Hon'ble Court;

d) Pass such further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice, equity and fairness."

4. *Vide* order dated 12.11.2025 in W.P.(C) 16972/2025, the learned Single Judge of this Court had passed the following directions: -

"2. After some hearing, it is agreed that the petitioners' application for participation/allotment of stalls in the forthcoming trade fairs, including India International Trade Fair (IITF) 2025 scheduled from 14.11.2025, shall be considered on priority, and if feasible, the petitioners shall be accommodated. Let the requisite decision be taken on priority. Till the same is done, the respondents shall not make any allotment to any other party/applicant.

3. In case, the petitioners are not accommodated, the rationale thereof and the applicable policy on the basis of which the stalls are allotted, as also the manner of working out inter-se priority, shall be duly provided to the petitioners. The same shall be subject to the legal rights and remedies of the petitioners."

5. Issue notice.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice.

7. Let a compliance affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing. In case of non-compliance, the concerned Officer shall remain present before the Court on the next date of hearing.
