ORDER

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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 74247/2025 (exemption)

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Application is disposed of.

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3. The present petition under Section 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act seeks following prayers:-

“It is therefore respectfully prayed to this Hon'ble Court that the contempt proceedings may kindly be initiated against the respondents and they be punished according to law for violating the order dated 17.10.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, in Review Pet. No.532/2025, titled as , " Sh . Anis Rana Vs. MCD & Ors.", in the interest of justice.

Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper may also be passed in favour of the petitioner and against the respondents .”



4. *Vide* order dated 17.10.2025 in W.P.(C) 15614/2025, the Single Judge of this Court passed the following directions:-

“5. This Court notes that *vide* order dated 10th October, 2025, this Court had noted the submission made by learned counsel appearing for the MCD that a Show Cause Notice against the unauthorized construction has already been issued. Thus, the MCD had been held bound to carry out the requisite action, after following the due process, and in accordance with law.

6. Since, it is the contention of the petitioner that unauthorized construction is still being carried out, it is directed that the MCD, with the assistance of the Local Police, shall ensure that no further unauthorized construction takes place in the property in question.

7. The Special Task Force ("STF"), which is a party and respondent no. 3 before this Court, is directed to ensure that the requisite action is taken by the MCD and that requisite assistance in the action against the unauthorized construction is given by the Local Police.”

5. Issue notice.

6. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents no. 1 to 3 and respondent no. 4 accepts notice. Let a status report be filed within a period of three weeks.
