1. This application has been filed by the revisionist. It is submitted by counsel for revisionist that parties have compromised the disputes and the revisionist has brought the balance amount of fine/compensation in the form of demand draft.
2. One person present in Court introduces himself as respondent but till date no notice was issued, so it cannot be ascertained that the person is respondent only.
