**ORDER**  
**08.04.2025**

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1. A suit was, initially, filed by the Syndicate Bank seeking recovery of Rs.3,38,128.82/-.
2. When the abovesaid suit was taken up by the learned Trial Court on 05.02.2019, since there was no appearance from the side of the plaintiff Bank, it was dismissed for non-appearance and for non-prosecution.
3. Admittedly, thereafter, as per the Gazette Notification issued on 04.03.2020, the Syndicate Bank got amalgamated with Canara Bank.
4. Since there were lot of NPA accounts in the erstwhile Syndicate Bank and since after merger, the details were not readily available, an application seeking restoration could be filed in the year 2023 only. It has also been mentioned that, in the interregnum, no step could be taken on account of Pandemic of Covid-19.
5. The grievance in the present petition is with respect to dismissal of such application and also of review application.

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6. It seems that no notice has, so far, been issued.
7. On taking steps, let notice be issued to respondent through all permissible modes, returnable on 23.09.2025. Notice be also issued through counsel.
