1. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-

“(a) quash the Order dated 18.03.2025 issued by the Respondent No.2, whereby it has withdrawn the recognition of Petitioner Institution for conducting B.Ed. course, in an arbitrary and illegal manner; and (b) quash the Order dated 09/21.07.2025 issued by the Respondent No.1 whereby the it has rejected the Statutory Appeal of the Petitioner Institution & has confirmed the Withdrawal Order dated 18.03.2025 issued by the Respondent No.2; and (c) consequent direct the Respondent No.2 to issue order of restoration of Petitioner’s recognition; Reflect on its official website, the status of the Petitioner Institution as recognized for running B.Ed. course; and communicate the said recognized status to the Petitioner’s Affiliating University and the State Department of Higher Education.”
