1. Vide order dated 03.08.2022 the Hon'ble Court has, *inter alia*, passed the following order:-

“4. The present application has been filed by the respondent for release of the balance amount lying in this Court. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he is in dire need of money. Learned counsel for the appellant has filed his reply opposing the application. The main concern of the appellant is that if the appeal is decided in favour of the appellant, the respondent will not be in a position to return the money. The concern of the appellant can be addressed by ensuring adequate security for release of the money. Hence, it is directed to release the balance deposited amount to the respondent, subject to his furnishing security to the satisfaction of the Registrar General of this Court.”

2. The perusal of the ordersheets reveal that the Hon'ble Court vide order



dated 12.03.2018 had directed to release the amounts to the respondent subject to the respondent furnishing adequate security. Pursuant to the aforesaid direction, respondent had furnished a security and my learned predecessor vide order dated 26.09.2018 had directed to release the amount deposited by the appellant in terms of order dated 31.01.2018 and 12.03.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Court. I need not reproduce the entire order all over again. Suffice it to say that the present proceedings primarily relate to release the balance amount which is deposited by the appellant in compliance of order dated 01.04.2016 passed by the Hon'ble Court.

3. As per office report an amount of Rs. 2,88,000/- is lying deposited in the shape of four FDRs.

4. The proxy counsel appearing for learned counsel for the respondent prays for one weeks' time for furnishing security bond. Let the same be furnished with advance copy to the other side.

5. Renotify on 06.09.2022.
