3. Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR bearing no. 58/2013 registered at Police Station - Saket for the offences punishable under Sections 406/498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
4. Issue notice. Learned APP for State, who appears on advance notice, accepts notice and seeks some time to file status report.
5. Let the same be filed three days prior to the next date of hearing.
