1. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The Applicant shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 8549/2025 & CRL.M.A. 35679/2025 (for stay)

4. Mr. C.S. Mohan Rao, Senior Counsel for the Petitioner, submits that the Petitioner and the Complainant amicably settled their disputes in mediation and executed a Settlement Agreement on 17th April, 2025. Pursuant to the terms of settlement, an amount of INR 34 lakhs has already been paid to Respondent No. 2; however, the complainant is not cooperating



in the process of quashing the impugned FIR.

5. Issue notice. APP for the State accepts notice.
6. Status report, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
7. Notice be served on the Complainant, through the Investigating Officer, returnable before the next date of hearing.
8. Considering that a mediation settlement has been executed by the complainant and a substantial amount of INR 34 lakhs has already been paid, further proceedings before the Trial Court arising from the impugned FIR shall remain stayed.
