2. The present application preferred on behalf of the petitioner/applicant under Order I Rule 10 (2) and Order XXII Rule 10, read with Section 151 of the CPC, seeks the following prayers:-



- A. Allow the present application and bring on record Ms. Andrea J. Smith as the present authorized representative of Respondent No.1 Company in place of the erstwhile officer Late Ms. Helen L. Winslow for the purposes of the present contempt proceedings;
 - B. Allow the Petitioner to amend the Memo of Parties by substituting the name of Respondent No.2 from V.F. Brands India Pvt. Ltd. (formerly known as V.F. Arvind Brands Pvt. Ltd.) to Kontoor Brands India Private Limited, in view of the subsequent change in name, and direct that the same be taken on record;
 - C. Direct the Respondents to disclose the particulars of the present officers/persons holding positions corresponding to Respondent Nos. 4 and 5, in the event of any change in incumbency, and place the same on record;
 - D. Allow the Petitioner to bring on record the amended memo of Parties;
 - E. Pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case.
3. Issue notice.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 1/non-applicant accepts notice and seeks time to file a response. Let response be filed within two weeks, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner who may file a rejoinder thereto, within two weeks.
5. Re-notify on 24.08.2026.
6. In the meantime, subject to the decision on the aforesaid application, the petitioner/applicant may place on record an amended memo of parties.
