3. The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:

“(i) Issue directions to SHO, New Ashok Nagar, East Delhi to register the FIR against the accused persons on the basis of complaint dt. 03.08.2021 against the named accused persons/respondents no. 2 to 6 and completes the investigation in a time



bound manner in the interest of justice and equity.

(ii) Quash the order dt. 05.10.2024 passed by Sh. Subhash Kumar Mishra, ASJ - 3, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi in CRL. Revision Petition No. 284/2023 titled as Kaushalya Sharma Vs. State & Ors. in the interest of justice and equity.

(iii) Pass such other and further order as this Hon'ble court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case in the interest of justice and equity."

4. Heard.

5. Issue notice. Learned APP for the State appearing on advance notice accepted notice and vehemently opposed the instant petition. He prayed for two weeks' time to file status report. Let the same be filed within two weeks as prayed.

6. Issue notice to the respondent nos. 2 to 6 through all permissible modes on filing PF within one week.

7. List on 3rd March, 2025.
