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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Application is disposed of.

CONT.CAS(C) 1835/2025

3. The present petition under Sections 2(b)/12 read with Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks following prayers:-

“a) Try and punish the Contemnor /Respondents for having committed contempt for violation of settlement agreement dated 30.04.2025 and Order dated 28.05.2025 of Ld. Trial Court, South District, Saket Court, in case No. CS (Comm.) 120/2025, in accordance with law
b) Pass any other order and/ or further orders, which this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and in the circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the



present petition has been filed against the respondent for violation of order dated 28.05.2025 in CS(COMM.) 120/2025. It is further submitted that as per the settlement agreement dated 30.04.2025 total amount of Rs. 19,78,476/- was to be paid by the respondent to the petitioner by 30.09.2025. It is pointed out that only Rs. 4,00,000/- have been paid.

5. Issue notice to respondent, on petitioner taking necessary steps, through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 30.04.2026.

6. In the meantime, let a compliance affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing.

7. In case of non-compliance respondents No. 2 to 4 shall remain present in Court on the next date of hearing.
