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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

**CM APPL. 76121/2025, CM APPL. 76122/2025(exemptions) & CM APPL. 76123/2025(exemption from entire record before the Labour court)**

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. These applications are disposed of.

**W.P.(C) 18387/2025 & CM APPL. 76205/2025(stay)**

3. The present petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers: -

- “i. For issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing and setting aside the *ex-parte* Award dated December 4, 2023 passed by the Ld. Presiding Officer, Labour Court- 07, Rouse Avenue Courts, New Delhi in LID No. 152 of 2017, and all actions taken in pursuance thereof;
- ii. For issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing and setting aside the Impugned Recovery Certificate bearing No. F.23(26)/SD/Imp./2024/2297 dated July 18, 2025 issued by the Deputy Labour Commissioner,



South District, Labour Department, Government of NCT of Delhi;  
iii. For issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing and setting aside the Impugned Notice dated November 21, 2025 issued by Respondent No. 2, i.e., the Office of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (Saket), Revenue Department, Govt. of NCT, Delhi bearing F.No.1(51)/REC/SDM/SAKET/2025;  
iv. For grant of any other relief/reliefs to the Petitioner as permissible in accordance with law.”

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned award dated 04.12.2023, had been passed *ex-parte* on account of the proceedings being transferred from the learned Labour Court, Dwarka to the learned Labour Court, Rouse Avenue and consequently, there was change in the case numbering of the said proceedings. He further submits that the petitioner was never informed of the said proceedings by way of any notice with regard to the same.
5. Issue notice.
6. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 30.04.2026.
7. In the meantime, on petitioner depositing a sum of Rs. 50,000/- along with interest in terms of the impugned award dated 04.12.2023, before the Worthy Registrar General of this Court within a period of 4 days, the recovery proceedings shall remain stayed. In case the said amount is not deposited, the recovery proceedings shall continue in accordance with law.
8. The Registry is directed to requisition the digitized copy of the Trial Court Record with proper index, pagination and bookmarks for the perusal of this Court before the next date of hearing.
9. Copy of this order be sent to the learned Dy. Labour Commissioner,



South District/ learned Presiding Officer, Labour Court- 07, Rouse Avenue Courts, New Delhi for necessary information and compliance.
