1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 76364/2025 (Exemption)

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application is disposed of.

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3. The present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeks the following prayers:

“a) Pass appropriate directions in terms of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, against the Contemnors for breach of the Order and Judgment dated 02.07.2025 passed by this Hon’ble Court in W.P. (C) No. 6532/2010;

b) Summon the Contemnors and punish them for contempt and violation of Order and Judgment dated 02.07.2025 passed by this Hon’ble Court in W.P. (C) No. 6532/2010 and direct them to purge the contempt;

c. Pass any other or further orders as this Hon’ble Court may



deem fit.”

4. *Vide* judgment dated 02.07.2025 in W.P.(C) 6532/2010, the learned Division bench of this Court had passed the following directions: -

“11. Keeping in view the above, the effect of promotion from HS Grade-I to HS Grade-II granted to the petitioners stood negated by the merger of two posts. The petitioners were, therefore, entitled to the first ACP on completion of 12 years of their service from initial appointment.

12. Accordingly, the Impugned Order is set aside. The respondents are directed to rework and grant the consequential benefits to the petitioners along with interest @ 6 % per annum from the date of their entitlement for the same. This exercise must be completed within a period of twelve (12) weeks from today.”

5. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 27.03.2026.

6. Let a compliance report be filed before the next date of hearing. In case of non-compliance, the concerned Officer shall remain present before the Court on the next date of hearing.
