1. Issue notice. Notice be served upon the respondents by all permissible modes, additionally through learned counsel appearing on their behalf before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal ["Tribunal"], if any.



2. The appellants assail a judgment dated 22.08.2025 passed by the Tribunal in MACT No. 300/2016, whereby an award was made in favour of the respondents – claimants arising out of a fatal accident.
3. Mr. Chaitanya Mehta, learned counsel for the appellants, has drawn my attention to paragraph 19 of the impugned award, wherein the Tribunal has relied upon video footage recorded by a proximate CCTV camera. He submits that this video footage was never placed on record before the Tribunal.
4. Trial Court record be summoned, and an electronic copy thereof be placed on the file of this appeal.
5. Written submissions be filed by the parties, with reference to the electronic record of the Court, alongwith copies of any relevant judgments which they wish to rely upon, within eight weeks from today.
6. Subject to deposit of the awarded amount by the appellants before the Tribunal, alongwith up-to-date interest, the execution of the impugned award shall remain stayed until the next date of hearing. The amount will be deposited in two instalments – 50% within a period of six weeks from today, and the remaining 50%, alongwith the balance accrued interest up to the date of deposit, within a period of six weeks thereafter.

8. List before the Court on 28.04.2026.
