6. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-

“(a) Issue an appropriate Writ / Order / Direction and quash and set aside



the impugned Letter of Disapproval dated 17.09.2025 issued by Respondent No. 1, whereby the Petitioner's Application for establishment of a new medical college with an intake of 150 MBBS seats for Academic Year 2025 – 26 has been disapproved; and

(b) Issue an appropriate Writ / Order / Direction and quash and set aside the Order dated 11.10.2025 issued by the Appeal Committee of Respondent No. 1, whereby the Petitioner's First Appeal against the Letter of Disapproval dated 17.09.2025 for establishment of a new medical college with an intake of 150 MBBS seats for Academic Year 2025 – 26 has been rejected; and

(c) Issue appropriate Writ / Order / Direction, directing Respondent Nos. 1 & 2 to grant / issue the Letter of Permission to the Petitioner College to establish a new medical college with an intake of 150 MBBS students for the Academic Year 2025 – 26, on the basis of the Assessment / Inspection Report dated 30.06.2025 and the contemporaneous records; and

(d) In the alternative, issue an appropriate Writ / Order / Direction directing the Respondent Nos. 1 & 2 to forthwith conduct a compliance – verification inspection, if necessary, and thereafter pass a fresh, reasoned Order within a short, fixed timeline granting the Petitioner permission for intake of 150 MBBS seats; and

(e) Direct the Respondents in the interim and during the pendency the present Writ Petition, to allow the Petitioner to participate in the counselling process, if any, and as when and where such counselling is scheduled by the Respondents to be conducted by the Respondents and to be declared in due course; and”

7. Issue notice.
8. Mr. T. Singhdev, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of Respondents No.1 and 2.
9. Mr. Vinay Yadav, learned CGSC accepts notice on behalf of Respondent No.3.
10. Counter affidavits be filed within a period of four weeks from today.
11. Rejoinder, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
12. List on 12.01.2026.
