1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 2/11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act seeks following prayers:-

“A. Initiate and take the necessary action against the contemnor/respondent for the willful disobedience of the judgment dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Hon'ble Court in the Civil Writ Petition No. 7035/2025 in case titled as "Ashish Thakur Versus Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited" as per section 2, section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and the rules framed there under.

B. Direct the contemnor/respondent to comply to the judgment dated 26.05.2025, in the interest of justice.

C. Pass any other order or further orders which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. *Vide* order dated 26.05.2025, learned Single Judge of this Court had passed the following directions:-

“7. In the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent / DSIIDC to decide the aforesaid



representation of the petitioner dated 01.04.2025. Let the same be done expeditiously. If permissible as per applicable rules and procedures, let the necessary permission for Change in Constitution be accorded by the respondent. If the same is sought to be denied, let a reasoned order be passed by the respondent.

8. Let the aforesaid exercise be completed within a period of 8 weeks from today.

9. In case further documents are required by the respondent from the petitioner for the purpose of disposal of its representation, the same shall be duly provided by the petitioner, including those sought by way of communication dated 24.01.2025, i.e. the deficiency letter issued by the DSIIDC (which has been appended as Annexure-P2 to the present petition).”

4. Issue notice to respondent, on petitioner taking necessary steps, through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 22.04.2026.

5. In the meantime, let a compliance report be filed before the next date of hearing. In case of non-compliance, the concerned Officer of respondent shall remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing.
