ORDER

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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks, the following prayers:-

“A. Issue notice to the alleged contemnors, including SDM/RA Alipur Sh. Shrikant R. Tapdiya and any successor, calling upon them to show cause why proceedings for civil contempt should not be initiated for wilful disobedience of the orders dated 28.05.2025 passed in WP (C) 7734/2025;

B. Initiate contempt proceedings against the Respondents under Sections 2(b) and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and punish them in accordance with law;

C. Direct the Respondent to comply with the order dated 28.05.2025 forthwith and in any case within a period of one week from the date of this Hon'ble Court's order in the present proceedings, by passing reasoned orders on the Petitioners' mutation applications;

D. Award costs of these proceedings to the Petitioner;

E. Pass any other or further order(s) which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case.”



3. *Vide* order dated 28.05.2025, the learned Single Judge of this Court had passed the following directions:-

“2. As the relief sought, at this stage, is only for consideration of mutation applications, the petition is disposed of, with the direction that the respondent may pass necessary orders on the applications within a period of three months from today.”

4. Issue notice.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents accepts notice. Let a compliance affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing.

6. List on 28.04.2026.

7. In case of non-compliance, the concerned SDM shall remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing.
