ORDER

05.12.2025

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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts

Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers:-

“a). To initiate contempt proceedings against the respondent for having committed contempt of this Honorable Court by way of Deliberately and intentionally disobeying the order dated to 19.11.2024 & 17.11.2024 as Annexure P-1, passed by this Hon'ble Court in writ petition (civil) No. 4027 of 2024.

b) To punish the respondent for having committed contempt of this Hon'ble Court.

c) To pass such other and further orders directions as this on Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. *Vide* order dated 19.11.2024, the learned Single Judge of this Court in CM APPL. 67245/2024 in W.P.(C) 4027/2024, had passed the following



directions:-

“5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the School on advance copy of the application submits, on instructions, that the School has no objection if the Petitioner rejoins the School on the post of TGT (Social Science), subject however to the approval by Directorate of Education (DoE). Mr. Dhingra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of DoE submits that once the School sends the proposal, the same shall be considered expeditiously.

6. Accordingly, this application is disposed of recording the submission of the School that it has no objection to the Petitioner joining back on the post of TGT (Social Science). It is directed that the School will send a proposal to the DoE in this regard as early as possible and on receipt of the same, DoE shall consider the same and take a decision. The entire exercise will be completed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of this order by the School.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the aforesaid directions are not being complied with by respondent no.3 school.
5. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to respondent no. 3, *i.e.*, Vice Principal, Diwan Chand Arya, Senior Secondary School, Lodhi Road, through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable for the next date of hearing.
6. Notice is issued only to respondent no. 3 at this stage.
7. Let a compliance affidavit be filed before the next date of hearing.
8. In case of non-compliance, respondent no. 3 shall remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing.
9. Renotify on 27.04.2026.
