1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the appellant, seeking to place on record certain documents, i.e., the Trademark Registration Certificates and Status Pages, as additional evidence.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits that by way of the present application, Status Pages of the Trademark Registration Certificates of 'Aaj Tak' in Class 38 and Class 41, which had already been



filed before the Additional District Judge (“ADJ”), are sought to be placed on record. Subsequently, the appellant had also acquired registration of ‘Aaj Tak’ in Class 16. The application for registration of Trademark in Class 16 had been filed in the year 2021, i.e., after the filing of the present appeal, and therefore, the same could not have been filed at the stage of filing the appeal before this Court.

3. Thus, the documents are sought to be placed on record.
4. The said documents have already been filed, along with the present application.
5. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 1.
6. Respondent no. 2 is already proceeded *ex-parte*.
7. Learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 1, on instructions, submits that he has no objection if the present application is allowed, and the documents are placed on record. However, he submits that the respondent be granted liberty to address arguments, as regards the applicability and relevance of the said documents.
8. The aforesaid liberty is granted.
9. Accordingly, it is directed that the documents filed along with the present application, are taken on record.
10. Delay, applicability and relevancy of the said documents, shall be seen at the time of final adjudication.
11. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is accordingly disposed of.

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12. For further arguments on behalf of the appellant, re-notify on 20th



February, 2026.

13. The present is a part-heard matter.
