1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 29A(4) & (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner seeks extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of 12 months with effect from 09.01.2025 for concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal has expired on 23.12.2024. He further submits that though the original mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal lapsed on 23.12.2022, it was extended vide order of this Court dated 19.12.2023 till 23.02.2024 and subsequently modified to extension till 23.12.2024 vide order dated



10.01.2024, however, the proceedings could not be completed within the stipulated time.

3. Issue notice to the respondent by all permissible modes including through the counsel, who is representing the respondent before the Arbitral Tribunal as well as *dasti* notice, returnable on 27.01.2025.
