3. By way of the present petition, the petitioner is seeking following prayers:

“(a) Quash/set aside orders/directions dated 16.04.2024 and 07.12.2024 in CT. Case No. 625150/2016; Dinesh 12 Cummra v. Dr. Anil Kumar Kansal & Ors.; pending before Ld. JMFC, Saket Court (South-east), New Delhi, and any other consequential proceedings requiring repeated inquiry on the same set of facts concerning Dinesh Cummra v. Dr. Anil Kumar Kansal & Ors. as being contrary to the NMC Act, 2019, and beyond the scope of inquiry provided by Sections 27 and 30 thereof; and

(b) Declare that the procedure contemplated under Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations,



2002 and Sections 27 and 30 of the NMC Act, 2019 is exhaustive, and repeated or parallel inquiries absent new material or statutory appeal cannot be insisted upon by forums trial courts; and

(c) Declare that the order passed by the Delhi Medical Council dated 13.07.2017 is final and binding, subject to statutory appeal as per law, and that the NMC is not required to conduct repeated inquiries absent new material;

4. Issue notice to respondents through all permissible modes, including electronically, on filing of process fee.
