1. Issue notice. Mr Manav Bhalla, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.
2. It has been agreed by the learned counsel for the parties that they shall file their respective written synopsis not exceeding five pages, giving a chronological list of dates and events and relevant documents, if any, alongwith duly highlighted judgments setting out the proposition of law therein, they wish to rely upon within the period of six weeks.
