3. This is an application filed by the Appellant under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963, seeking condonation of delay of 249 days in filing the present appeal.
4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the reasons assigned in the application, the present application is allowed and the delay is condoned.
5. Accordingly, the present application stands disposed of.

6. The present appeal has been filed under Section 415(2) of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023* (“BNSS”) assailing the Judgment dated 30.11.2024 and Order on Sentence dated 29.01.2025, passed by the learned Trial Court in Session Case No. 440495/2016 pertaining to FIR No. 1527/2015, under Sections 302/308/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dabri, Delhi.

7. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that *vide* Judgment dated 30.11.2024, the appellant has been convicted under Sections 302/308/34 IPC, and by Order on Sentence dated 29.01.2025, he has been, *inter alia*, sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life.

8. Admit.

9. Learned APP accepts notice of admission of appeal.

10. The Registry is directed to prepare the paper book with e-pagination and all the parties are at liberty to obtain the copy of the paper book from the Registry, if so desire.

11. The Registry shall ensure that the paper book is prepared and placed on record, before the next date of hearing.

CRL.M.(BAIL) 2472/2025

14. The present application has been filed under Section 430 read with Section 528 of BNSS seeking suspension of sentence and release of the appellant on bail during the pendency of the present appeal.

15. Learned APP for the State seeks time to file reply.

16. Let the reply be filed before the next date of hearing, with advance copy to the opposite side.



17. The Nominal Roll of the appellant be also called, from the concerned Jail Superintendent, before the next date of hearing.

In view of the directions passed by the Supreme Court in the case of ***Kaushal Singh vs. The State of Rajasthan*** 2025 SCC OnLine SC 1473, decided on 18.07.2025, let learned counsel for the appellant place an affidavit on record, thereby stating about the past involvement of the appellant in criminal case(s), if any, registered against him, containing all the particulars of the said case(s).
19. Let the affidavit be placed on record, before the next date of hearing, with advance copy to the opposite side.
