1. This is an application filed under Section 8 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('Act of 1996') and under Order VII Rule 11 read with Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') for rejection of plaint on behalf of the defendant.
