1. The petitioner seeks quashing of conviction order dated 22.01.2025 and sentencing orders dated 17.11.2025 and 18.11.2025, passed by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, Karkardooma Courts (East), Delhi in CT Case No. 53439/2016.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order of conviction and sentence, the parties have settled all of their disputes and the entire settlement amount of ₹1.20 crores has already been paid to the complainant.
