1. This suit has been filed for permanent injunction restraining trademark infringement, passing-off of trademark, acts of unfair competition, seeking damages/rendition of accounts, freezing of assets, delivery up and other appropriate relief.

2. A perusal of the plaint shows that this plaintiff had earlier instituted CS (COMM) 909/2024 against the same defendant nos. 1 and 2 and in that suit, an interim injunction order dated 18.10.2024 was passed in favour of the plaintiff and in fact, the suit itself for the relief of permanent injunction came to be decreed in favour of the plaintiff on 09.04.2025. The relevant prayer clauses which were inter alia decreed in favour of the plaintiff read as under:



“i. A decree of permanent injunction restraining the Defendant Nos. 1 to 5 and all persons acting for or on their behalf from using the Plaintiff's registered trademark VIMAL or any other mark identical or deceptively similar thereto, **in any manner whatsoever, including as a domain name, email address** or trade name, amounting to infringement of registered trademarks of the Plaintiff;

ii. A decree of permanent injunction restraining the Defendant Nos. 1 to 5 and all persons acting for or on their behalf from using the Plaintiff's registered trademark VIMAL or any other mark identical or deceptively similar thereto, **in any manner whatsoever, including as a domain name, email address or trade name**, amounting to *passing off* the services and products of the Defendant Nos. 1 to 5 as those of the Plaintiff;”

(Emphasis Supplied)

3. In the considered opinion of this Court, the relief prayed for in this plaint against defendant nos. 1 and 2 are available to the plaintiff by seeking execution of the decree dated 09.04.2025.

4. Learned counsel for the plaintiff seeks accommodation to take instructions.
