ORDER

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30.09.2019

1. The counsel for the judgment debtor (JD) No.5 states that the JD No.5 is 82 years old and ailing and is unable to appear today. It is further stated that JD No.5 has no assets or means of income except his pension. On enquiry, it is stated that the house in which he is residing belongs to his wife and son.
2. An affidavit of the JD No.5 detailing all his assets/belongings be filed within two weeks.
3. Last opportunity is given to the JD No.5 to appear on 30th January, 2020.
4. The decree holder (DH) did not take steps to serve the other JDs in spite of opportunity given on the last date of hearing.
5. Last opportunity is given to the DH to serve the other JDs by all modes including *dasti* and electronic and at any fresh address which may be furnished by the DH, returnable on 30th January, 2020, failing which the Execution Petition shall not be proceeded with further.

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6. The DH is also permitted to serve JD No.6 through counsel appearing for him in the appeal stated to have been preferred against the decree under execution.
