1. The service report *qua* defendant no.3 reveals that the said defendant could not be served on account of incomplete address.
2. Mr. Varun Singh, learned counsel for the plaintiff, submits that amended memo of parties have been filed giving new address of defendant no.3.
3. On plaintiff taking steps, issue fresh summons to defendant no.3, by all permissible modes, returnable on 30.03.2026, the date already fixed, before the learned Joint Registrar.
