3. The present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No. 25/2020 under Section 174A IPC registered at Police Station Subzi Mandi and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the ground that the parties have arrived at a settlement.
4. Mr. Ravi Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid FIR came to be registered as the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender under Section 138 of NI Act as he did not appear before the learned Trial Court.
5. He submits that during the pendency of the proceedings arising out of



aforesaid FIR, the learned JMFC (NI Act)-02, Central, Tis Hazari Courts, on an application moved by the petitioner has compounded offence under Section 138 of NI Act with respondent no.2, who was the complainant.

6. He submits that since the original offence out of which the aforesaid FIR has arisen has already been compounded, he urges the Court that the aforesaid FIR under Section 174A IPC also be quashed.

7. In view of the above, issue notice. Ms. Manjeet Arya, learned APP for the State accepts notice.

8. On petitioner taking steps, notice be issued to respondent no.2, by all permissible modes, returnable on 23.04.2026.

9. In the meanwhile, the proceedings pending before the learned Trial Court, if any, arising out of FIR No. 25/2020 under Section 174A IPC registered at Police Station Subzi Mandi, are stayed till the next date.
