CRL.M.A. 3521/ 2025 (for exemption)

1. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The Applicant shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 743/2025 and CRL.M.A. 3520/2025 (for stay)

4. The Petitioner assails the order dated 21st October, 2024 passed by the ASJ, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, whereby her husband, the accused – Yasir Khan (Respondent No. 2 herein) has been granted anticipatory bail. The Petitioner submits that the reason for granting bail is untenable as the order was passed without proper appreciation of the facts of the case. The accused



person is the husband of the Petitioner who, along with three of his brothers committed the horrendous crime of gang rape on Petitioner and threatened her that her sensitive images and videos would be circulated if she reported the incident to the police or her family and relatives.

5. Issue notice. APP for the State, accepts notice.
6. Let status report be filed, with copy thereof provided to the opposite party.
7. Issue notice to Respondent No. 2, upon filing of process fees, by all modes, returnable on the next date of hearing. Upon service, such Respondent shall file a reply within a period of two weeks from the date of service.
8. The Registry is directed to requisition the digitized copy of the Trial Court Record for the perusal of this Court with proper indexation, pagination and bookmarks.
