The present petition has been filed under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (the 'Act') seeking appointment of a Sole Arbitrator for the adjudication of the disputes between the parties arising out of a Loan Agreement dated 22nd November, 2024 ('Agreement'), entered into between the parties.
