Case file received from the court of Sh. Manish Sharma, learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) by way of transfer in terms of office order signed by learned Registrar (Original) on 28.06.2024.

1. The matter is at the stage of PE. As per office note, evidence by way of affidavit has not been filed. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged around 90 years and he could not contact the petitioner on account of his ill health.

2. The present Test. Cas. Pertains to the year 2014 and the issues were framed on 12.04.2017. The petitioner's evidence has not commenced yet. In case, the petitioner is not keeping good health, learned counsel for petitioner can take appropriate steps for recording of his evidence through learned Local Commissioner or video



conferencing. No such steps have been taken. Adjournment is being sought on the one ground or the other. Solely in the interest of justice, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner to either take steps for recording of his evidence through learned Local Commissioner or video conferencing or the petitioner shall positively appear in person on the next date.

3. Evidence by way of affidavit along with its hard copy be filed positively within three weeks. It shall be the last opportunity failing which this court would be constrained to close the petitioner's evidence.

4. Re-notify the matter for PE/Cross on 11.11.2024.
