1. The present is an application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ("CPC"), on behalf of the petitioner, seeking exemption from filing typed legible/dim copies of document nos. 2 to 7.

6. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to Clause 21 of the said Collaboration Agreement to submit that there exists an Arbitration Clause for adjudication of any disputes/claims that may arise between the parties.

7. He further draws the attention of this Court to the copy of notice dated 31st October, 2025, issued by the petitioner as per Section 21 of the Arbitration Act, thereby invoking arbitration under Clause 21 of the Collaboration Agreement.

8. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 3 to 5.

9. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that respondent nos. 1 and 2 are also related to respondent nos. 3 to 5.

10. Accordingly, learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 3 to 5 is directed to take instructions, as to whether he shall also represent respondent nos. 1 and 2.
