1. This is a writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“a. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction in the nature of mandamus, commanding Respondent No.1 to adjudicate and decide the Complaint bearing No. N202526023029622 Dated 16.04.2025 filed by the Petitioner strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months;

b. Set aside the Impugned Order dated 04.07.2025 in Complaint bearing No. N202526023029622 Dated 16.04.2025 passed by the Respondent No.1;”

2. Mr. Mahajan, learned counsel for the petitioner, states among other grounds, that the respondent No.1 has dismissed the complaint of the



petitioner on limitation. However, respondent No. 1 has wrongly construed the date of commencement of limitation as 31.03.2020 in place of 06.07.2024.

3. For the said reasons, issue notice to the respondents.

4. Mr. Rout, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No. 2.

5. Issue notice to the respondent No. 1 through all modes including electronic on the petitioner taking steps within 1 week from today, returnable on 29.04.2026.
