W.P.(C) 322/2026

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“1. Pass an order for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to the Respondent(s) for un freezing the account number 0632000195107080 belong to the Petitioner namely, Harjeet Kaur, situated at Punjab National Bank, Tilak Nagar Branch, New Delhi- 110018.

2. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus to the Respondent



No. 3 to give his consent for unfreezing of account and also for disclosure of reasons as to why he had interfere in the life of the Petitioner despite giving an oath on the settlement agreement dated 13.08.2024, in the Hon'ble Tis Hazari Court, Delhi.

3. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus to the Respondent No. 1, to convert the said account into single/self account in the name of the Petitioner.”

2. It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the account has been put on hold due to an RTI issued by the respondent No.3 (ex-husband [divorced] of the petitioner).
3. For the said reasons, issue notice.
4. Ms. Vairagi and Ms. Desai, learned counsels accept notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 respectively.
5. Let notice be issued to the respondent No. 3 through all modes including electronic on the petitioner taking steps within 1 week from today, returnable on 18.02.2026.
