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I.A. 558/2026 (Exemption from filing certified copies of documents)

1. The present is an application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ("CPC"), on behalf of the plaintiffs, seeking exemption from filing certified copies of annexures/documents.
2. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
3. Plaintiffs shall file certified copies of the documents, on which the plaintiffs may seek to place reliance, before the next date of hearing.
4. Accordingly, the present application is disposed of.

5. Let the plaint be registered as suit.
6. Issue summons. Summons is accepted by learned counsel appearing for defendant nos. 1 and 3 to 21. The said defendants shall file written statements within thirty (30) days, from today.
7. Issue summons to the defendant no. 2, by all permissible modes upon filing of Process Fee.
8. Summons shall state that the written statement be filed by the defendant within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of summons.
9. Along with the written statement, the defendant shall also file an affidavit of admission/denial of the plaintiffs' documents, without which, the written statement shall not be taken on record.
10. Liberty is given to the plaintiffs to file replication within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of the written statement. Further, along with the replication, if any, filed by the plaintiffs, an affidavit of admission/denial of documents of the defendants, be filed by the plaintiffs, without which, the replication shall not be taken on record.
11. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
12. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of the documents, the same shall be sought, and given within the timelines.
13. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 10th March, 2026.
14. List before the Court on 24th April, 2026.

I.A. 557/2026 (Application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of CPC)

15. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for defendant nos. 1 and 3 to 21.



16. Issue notice to defendant no. 2 by all permissible modes, upon filing of Process Fee.
17. Let reply be filed within a period of four weeks.
18. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks, thereafter.
19. In the meanwhile, the defendants shall preserve all the ballot papers received in the office of the defendant no. 1-society and file the same along with the reply/written statement, including, video coverage of the counting process as well as the CCTV footage of the handing over of the ballot and counting process. The full election records shall also be filed by the defendants along with the reply/written statement.
20. List before the Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 10th March, 2026.
21. List before the Court on 24th April, 2026.
