CRL.M.A. 1515/2026 (exemption)

Exemption granted, subject to just exceptions.

Let requisite compliances be made within 01 week.

The application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 1514/2026 (condonation of 71 days' delay in filing)

By way of the present application filed under section 5 of the Limitation Act 1963 read with section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 ('BNSS'), the petitioner seeks condonation of about 71 days' delay in *filing* the present petition.

2. For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by affidavit, the delay is condoned.
3. The application is allowed and disposed-of.



4. The petition is taken on Board.

CRL.M.(BAIL) 94/2026 (suspension of sentence)

5. By way of the present petition filed under section 438 read with section 442 BNSS, the petitioner impugns judgment dated 21.07.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-02, South-East District, Saket Courts, New Delhi in C.A. No.85/2025.
6. After making some submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner submits, that the petitioner would be willing to amicably resolve the matter with the respondent.
7. In view of the plea of settlement as offered by the petitioner, issue notice, limited *only* to the aforesaid aspect.
8. Upon the petitioner taking requisite steps, let notice be sent to the respondent by all permissible modes, returnable for the next date.
9. The issuance of the notice shall however, be *subject to* the petitioner depositing the balance fine/compensation amount of Rs.1,82,500/- in court, within 02 weeks.
10. The Registrar General is directed to retain the said sum in the form of a fixed deposit in a nationalised bank, initially for a period of 01 year; to be renewed for the same period from time-to-time, without awaiting any further directions from this court in that behalf, unless otherwise directed by the court.
11. The Registry is directed to bring to the notice of this court any non-compliance with the directions issued above.
12. Re-notify on 04th May 2026.



13. *Subject to* the deposit being made as aforesaid, the default sentence imposed upon the petitioner shall not be executed, till the next date of hearing before this court.
