1. This application is disposed of with a direction to the applicant/ plaintiff to file certified / original copies of the documents sought to be relied upon, within a period of four weeks.

6. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

7. List before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 15.09.2026 for completion of service, pleadings, admission / denial of documents and marking of exhibits.

8. Learned counsel for the applicant seeks to withdraw the present application with liberty to file afresh after pleadings are completed.

9. The application is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
