According to the counsel for the appellant, if the benefit of the time period spent on pre-litigation mediation, i.e. the period from 03<sup>rd</sup> July, 2025 till 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2025, was extended to the appellant, then the suit ought to have been considered to be within the period of limitation.
