1. This petition has been filed with the following prayers:

“a) Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other writ or direction to quash and set aside the impugned Basic Pay Change Order No. 17/2025-ACCTS-BR- DA1-PAY-051BN dated 09.05.2025 and Office Order (Recovery 0055) dated 10.06.2025 issued by the Office of the Commandant. 51 BN CRPF, CRPF Campus Hallomajra, Chandigarh along with all the consequential acts which may be taken to the detriment of the Petitioner herein; and

b) Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other writ or direction to the Respondents to take a reasoned decision and issue appropriate directions to withdraw or quash the impugned Basic Pay Change Order No. 17/2025-ACCTS-BRDA1- PAY-051BN dated 09.05.2025 and the Order No. 48/2025-ACCTSBR- DA1-PAY-051BN dated 10 06.2025 both issued by



the Office of the Commandant, 51 BN CRPF, CRPF Campus Hallomajra, Chandigarh.

c) Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other writ or direction to the Respondents to cease and desist from making any further reductions or deductions to the Petitioners' salary, and reverse any such reductions and deductions to the Petitioners salary which has been already commenced.

d) Award costs of these proceedings to the Petitioners;"

2. The petition challenges the order dated 10.06.2025, whereby the respondent intends to change the basic pay of the petitioner and consequently effecting recovery.

3. Issue notice.

4. Mr. Dhananjai Rana, learned Central Government Standing Counsel accepts notice.

5. Till the next date of hearing, the respondent shall not effect any recovery from the salary of the petitioner.

6. Counter affidavit be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within two weeks thereafter.
