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1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking following prayers:

“a) Issue a writ of mandamus or any appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the Respondent National Medical Commission (NMC) to issue the Eligibility Certificate in favour of the Petitioner;

b) Declare that the Petitioner is entitled to the benefits of the Public Notice dated 07.12.2023 and the one-time exemption granted by this Hon'ble



Court vide order dated 27.09.2018 in WPC 8091/2018;

c) Set aside communication letter dated 01.08.2024 rejecting application R.15012/027043/2023-Regn (Annexure 8) and dated letter dated 09.09.2025 rejecting application R.15012/033973/ 2025-Regn (Annexure 10)

c) Pass any other order (s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and equity.”

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.
3. Mr. Singhdev, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1, seeks and is granted 4 weeks time to file reply.
4. Issue notice to respondent No. 2 through all modes, including electronic, on the petitioner taking steps, within one week from today, returnable on 24.04.2026.
