3. By way of the present petition, petitioner seeks following reliefs:

a) Pass / issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the respondents to de-freeze and restore full operational control over the petitioner's bank account, which has been illegally and arbitrarily debit-frozen pursuant to a cyber-complaint dated 21.09.2025, in violation of Sections 106 and 107 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, and thereby protect and enforce the petitioner's fundamental rights under Articles 14, 19(1)(g), and 21 of the Constitution of India;

b) Direct the Respondent no.2 to immediately unfreeze and restore full operation control of the Petitioner's said bank



account to enable the Petitioner to continue business operations and meet financial obligations;

c) Declare that the impugned action of freezing the entire bank account without notice, opportunity of hearing, reasons, or any procedural safeguards is arbitrary, disproportionate violate of Articles 14, Article 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution, and contrary to the principles of natural justice;

d) Award the cost of the Petition to the Petitioner;

4. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsel for the respondent no. 1. Reply be filed at least two days prior to the next date of hearing.
5. Issue notice to the respondent no.2 by all permissible modes, including electronically, returnable on the next date of hearing.
6. List on 16.09.2026.
7. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith.
